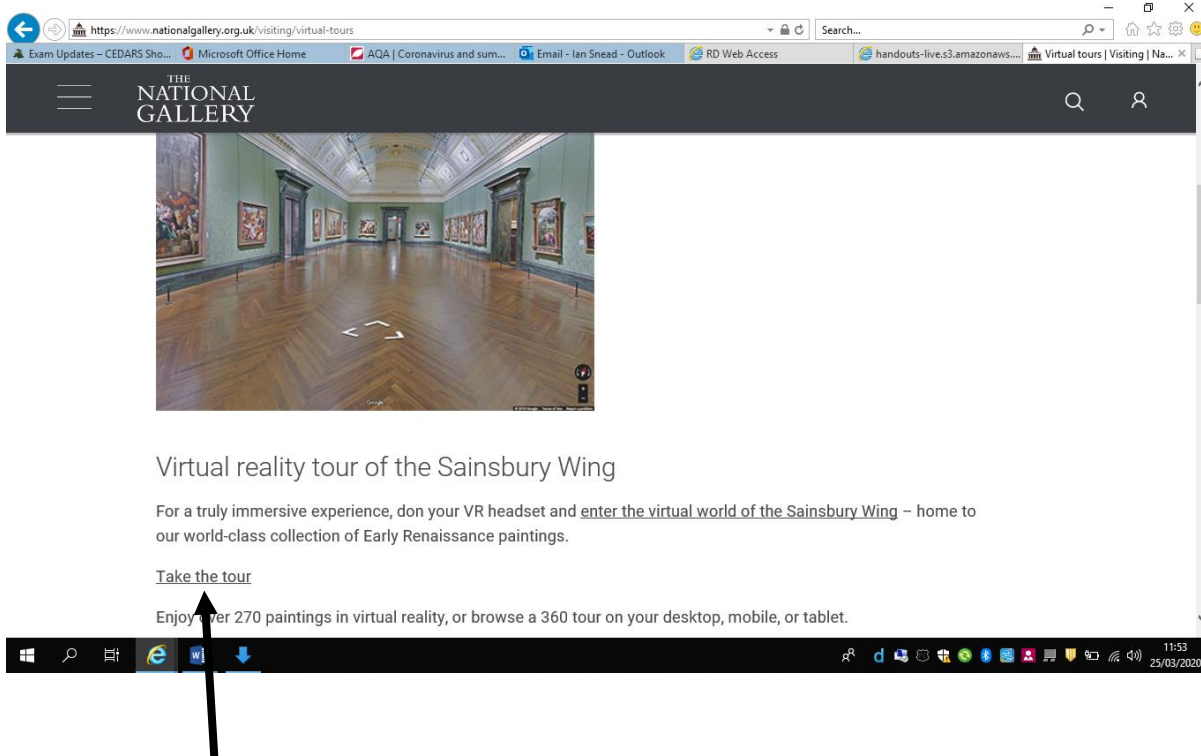


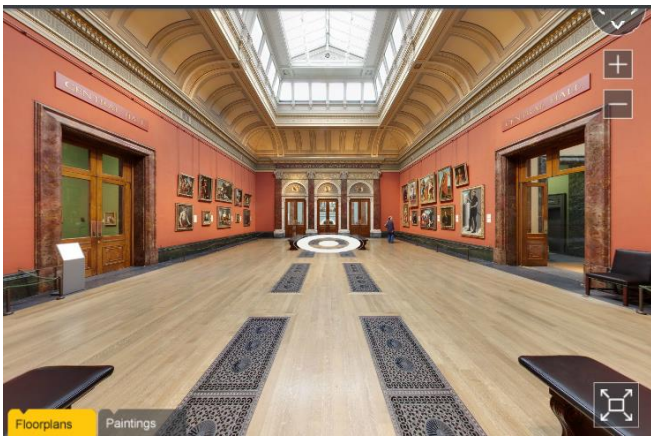
Art History/ Art Analysis:

Here is a bit of work to complete.

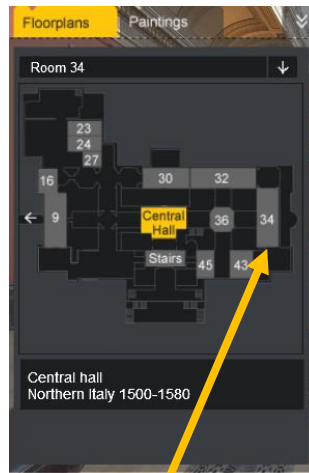

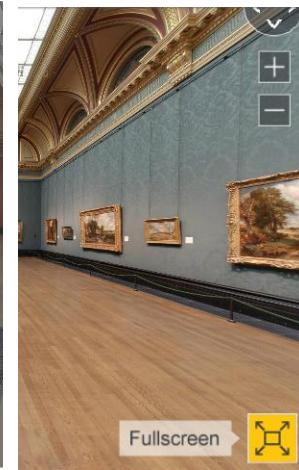
Then click Take a Tour

Then click Room 34

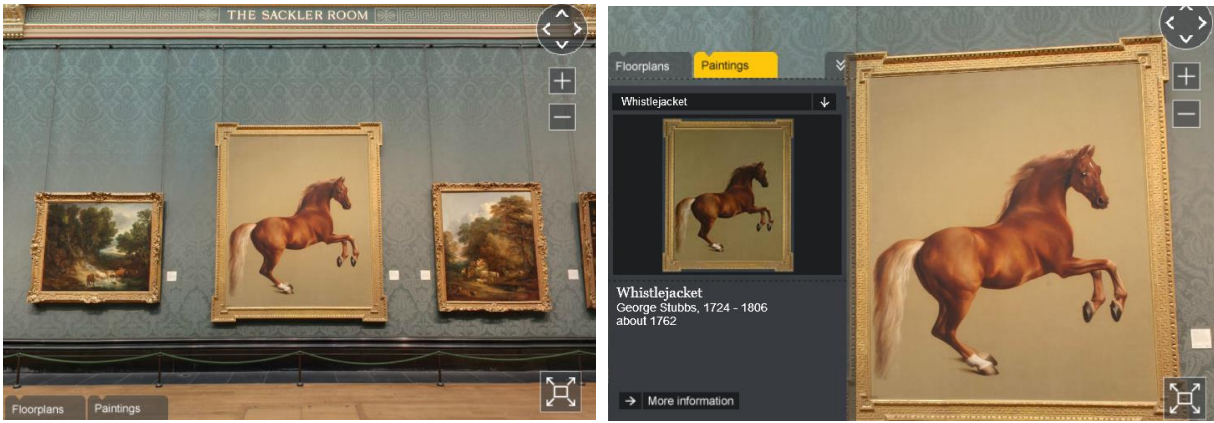


Then click full screen

Use your mouse or cursor keys to navigate around the room. Or change room.

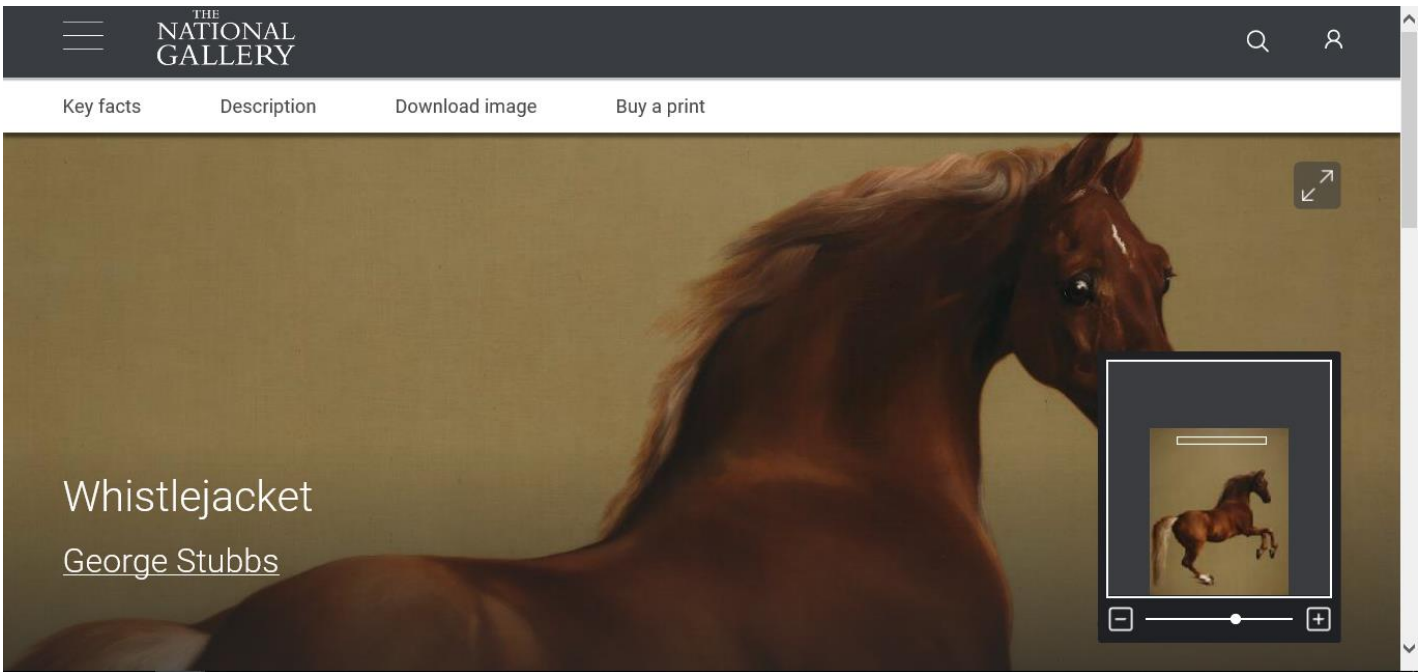
Find a picture you like:

Then click on it.

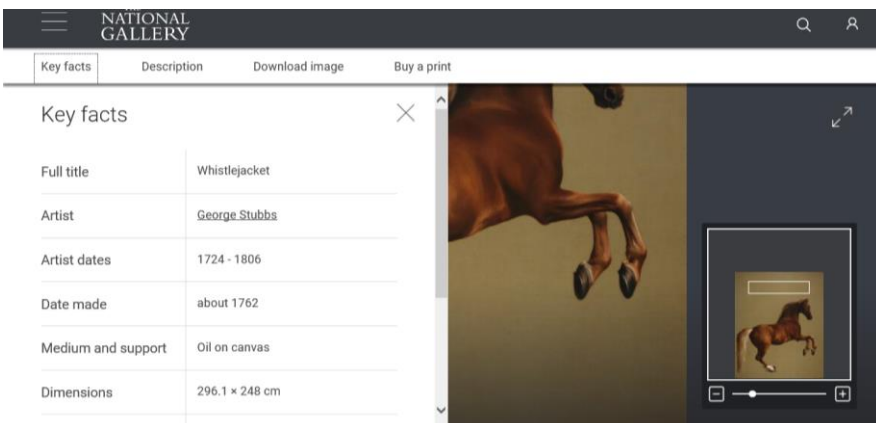
A pop up will appear so then click **More Information**

- How does it make me feel?
- Is there a message or metaphor in the work?

The download (low Resolution) means you can open it to attempt to draw it, or part of it
